For what purpose we collect and use your personal data?	Your personal data is collected non-disclosure or commercial use, and will be only for the following purposes:

	 Check is in fitness and count with skills to work in our company; Maintain a database of candidates for future hires. For employees:
	 4. Develop labor contract; 5. Register with Social Security; 6. Make payments; 7. Keep a file with records of our employees; 8. To fulfill legal obligations including tax and social security arising from employment obligations;
	 9. Provide data to law firms, and only in case of contingency, to exert the necessary legal action to resolve it. For former employees; 1. Keep your record in terms that we are bound by labor legislation.
	Personal data will be stored for a period of one year from obtaining and if employees and former employees, the term that marks the labor law even after completed under the strictest confidence

	and will not be able to give a different use to the above, unless there is a change in this Privacy Notice.

How you can exercise their ARCO rights to access or modify your personal data, cancel or oppose its use?	You have the right to access your personal data we possess and the details of their treatment and to correct them if they are inaccurate or incomplete; Cancel when you consider that are not required for any of the purposes specified in this privacy notice, they are being used for purposes nonconsensual or has completed the contractual or service, or object to the processing thereof for specific purposes.
	To exercise their rights ARCO, we require you send us a request to our e-mail <u>avisopriv@codiflex.com.mx</u> . You must comply with the requirements specified in the following section.
How you can revoke your consent to the processing of data, restrict its use or disclosure, including stop using your data for secondary purposes?	At any time, you may revoke the consent given to us for the processing of personal data and limit their use or disclosure, in order to stop making use of them. To do this, you need to submit your request:

	Demonstrating that you are the owner of the personal data or his legal representative, and where appropriate, with any official identification document and expressing the clear and precise

	description of the personal data on those seeking to exercise any right and any other item or document that facilitates the location of personal data and any other documents required by applicable law at the time of filing the application, as well as email which we will send our reply or phone to which we can contact you. Within a maximum period of 20 days from the date the request is received, we answer your request and inform you about the origin of it through an email to the address you have provided or, where applicable, we will a phone call to go to our home to receive the requested response. If the request is answered affirmatively or appropriate manner, the requested changes will be made within a maximum period of 15 working days. The charge may notify within the periods referred to in this paragraph the extension thereof, for once, for a period equal to the original.
How do we protect your personal data?	We pledge to do our utmost to protect the security of personal data provided to us by the conclusion of legal acts, through the use of technologies that control access, use or disclosure of personal information and related administrative measures in our company. We have security measures including restricted access to their files and constant monitoring of our systems access.
